Role Description - Sport and Exercise Medicine Specialty Exam Part 1 Lead

An exciting opportunity has become available as we are looking to recruit a new lead for the Sport and Exercise Medicine (SEM) Specialty Exam Part 1. This is a voluntary role.

About the Role

The SEM Specialty Exam Part 1 Lead should be a Fellow of the Faculty, a current FSEM examiner, and have prior experience with FSEM question writing and standard setting, including the Membership Part 1 examination.

The SEM Specialty Exam Part 1 Lead will support the FSEM Exams and Standards Manager clinically with the delivery of the single best answer exam, including:

- Advise the FSEM Exams and Standards Manager on all clinical aspects associated with the SEM Specialty Exam
- Review and maintenance of the SEM Specialty Exam Part 1 question bank by liaising with the FSEM Exams and Standards Manager
- Selection of SEM Specialty Exam Part 1 exam questions
- Attending and leading, together with the Exams and Standards Manager, question writing, and standard setting events associated with the exam
- Attendance of Exams Committee (held up to four times annually) and ad-hoc meetings with the FSEM Exams team or other committees if and when required
- Reporting to the Examination Committee Chair and Exams and Standards Manager, which includes four annual updates for Council.
- Attending, in person or remotely, FSEM's annual Exams Training Day with all exams leads.

The SEM Specialty Exam Part 1 Lead must be able to operate confidentially, with diplomacy, empathy and discretion and be able to demonstrate advanced interpersonal and communications skills.
