



Chair - Team Care Committee Role Description

An exciting opportunity has become available as we look to recruit a Chair for the new Team Care Committee for the Faculty of Sport and Exercise Medicine UK.

The Role:

The Chair of the Team Care Committee should be a Member or Fellow of the Faculty, with current or recent extensive experience on delivering team care services. The Chair must have previous leadership experience and be able to operate confidentially in leading the committee to implement the Faculty's strategy.

The Team Care Committee is the newest committee for FSEM, and the Chair will drive the committee to work on professional standards, supporting high quality, safe, professional practice, and develop policy and partnerships with national stakeholders. This committee has evolved from the previous Elite Sport Committee, who will now become an advisory group to the Team Care Committee. This new committee will continue to build on the progress they have already made.

The Chair of the Team Care Committee will work with the Faculty to appoint the first members to the Team Care Committee and set the committee's terms of reference.

Commitment:

- The Chair will be co-opted onto Council and will therefore attend quarterly Council meetings (3 meetings online usually 1-4pm online, with one in-person meeting in London, Birmingham, or Edinburgh).
- Quarterly Committee reports are due to Council on the progress, actions, or requests from the committee.

- The Chair will also meet with the Office Bearers group every 8 weeks during a 30-minute lunchtime update meeting
- Stakeholders' engagement meetings as and when required.
